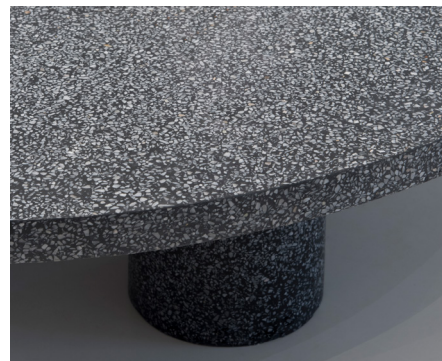


Three Cylinder Table
