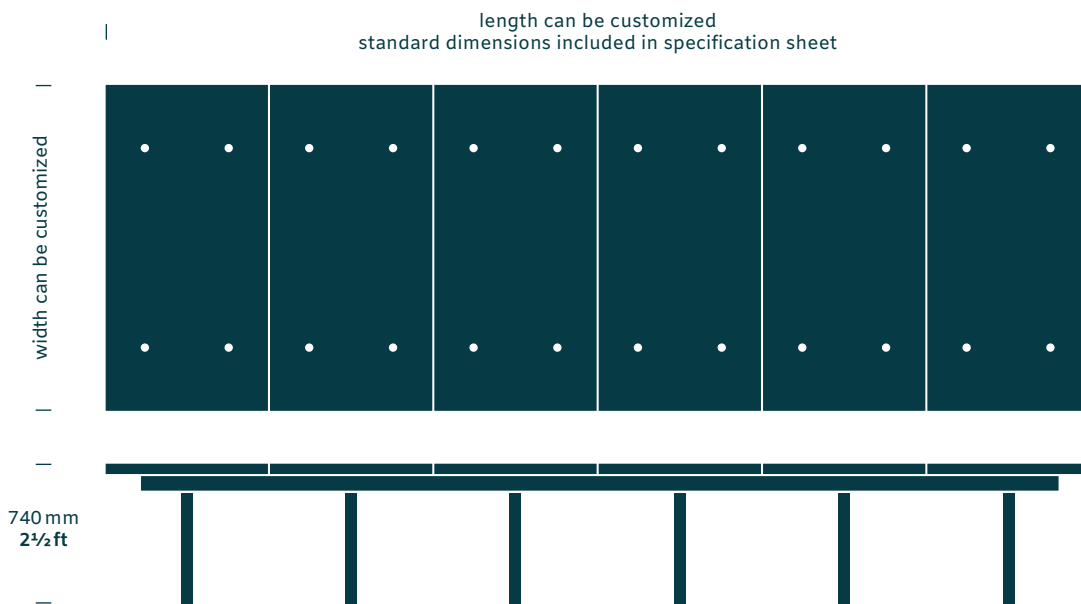


## Stone Wood Table



Constructed of timber posts and beams and fitted with thick slabs of marble, the table is built as one would erect a temple. Basic teakwood frames are joined with spanning members using simple pegs at the top of each column. The heavy stone is then aligned to rest securely above, completing the primitive structure.

## Dimensions

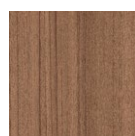
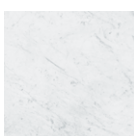


### Standard Dimensions

**12/18 seater Table:** 6 on each long side + 2 extra on each short side  
Top size: 3600 x 1200 mm (12 x 4 ft)

### Material

<b>Top</b>	White Marble	<b>Legs</b>	Teak
<b>Finish</b>	Natural	<b>Finish</b>	Sealed



### Assembly Instructions

Delivered disassembled. To be assembled as per provided drawing.  
Requires 4 to 6 people to be delivered and placed due to the weight.

### Care

We find beauty in the marks of unique character, subtle variations of grain, figure, and texture inherent in materials that deepen through use and patinate over time.

**Sealed wood:** Wipe regularly with a dry cotton cloth. Clean as required with a wood-specific mild detergent.

**Stone:** Being slightly porous, it requires simple wiping with a clean cloth.
